



SOLID MAHOGANY SHELL "BROADWAY" FLOATING HEAD SNARE DRUM







AUTOMATIC TENSION SNARES

This wonderful Leedy invention is now a part of the Parallel snare strainers on both Parallel and Dual model "Broadway" Drums. One end of each snare "floats" within a short coiled wire spring arranged alternately in two metal housings, one at each end. This spaces the snares so they cannot touch each other at any point and keeps them always at exactly the same tension. They align themselves on the springs.





INTERNAL SNARES-DUAL MODEL

Broadway DUAL Model Drums are equipped with an extra set of INTERNAL wire snares under the batter head. When used in conjunction with the outside Parallel snares they more than double the volume and carrying power in FFF playing. When used alone they permit extreme delicacy and snap in PPP playing. They operate in the same manner as the Parallel snares by means of an independent, easy-moving lever.

SELF-ALIGNING RODS

All Broadway Floating Head Drums are equipped with SELF-ALIGNING rods—an exclusive Leedy feature found on no other drum made. The receiving tubes (lugs) swing within the center supports (casings) on modified universal joints which are free to move in every direction. This assures a perfect alignment of threads which eliminates binding and stripping, and also permits a more uniform head tension.

FLOATING HEADS

Floating Head means that the flesh hoops do not and cannot touch the shell at any point of the circle. They fit snugly in the flanges of the counter hoops instead of hugging the shell as on other models. This eliminates all possibility of binding flesh hoops and reduces head breakage. Best of all, however, it guarantees even head tension, which in turn guarantees an easier playing, and better sounding, instrument.



Also because, with Nickel, Chromium or Nobby Gold Rods, it is appropriate in any orchestral setting. A sample of the Marine Pearl material (or any of the other "Full Dress" finishes) will be sent on request without obligation. Try giving it a few sharp blows with the butt end of a drum stick or bell mallet—notice that it will not dent or scratch. It is also guaranteed not to warp, crack, chip or peel. Only a soft, damp cloth is needed to remove the most stubborn dirt and to preserve its appearance of newness. A TIME SAVING DRUM HEAD TIP

It is not always necessary to retuck a drum head. Sometimes it is very inconvenient to do so on account of the time required and the trouble of getting the head off the flesh hoop, especially if it is old and well tucked. Besides, there is the danger of tearing same. Submerge the whole head and flesh hoop in water—not too cold, but not warm—for three minutes, then allow it to dry slowly. If it is a good head it will contract. After it is practically dry you can put it on the shell and adjust same as usual. This will often result in as good a job as retucking.


A LITTLE INFORMATION ABOUT DRUM HEADS

It is not heat and cold that affect snare and bass drum heads—it is the condition of the heat and cold, viz: dampness and dryness. A damp heat will cause the head to slacken, and the same with a damp cold. A dry heat will cause a head to tighten, and the same with a dry cold. Therefore, watch the condition of the atmosphere rather than the thermometer and avoid head breakage. If you have tightened your head on a damp night, let it out after using to the point where you started to take it up. This will allow some slack for a "take-up" should the next day be dry. If your drum works nicely in dry weather, leave it alone. Drummers who watch these points have been known to use the same head for years.

ABOUT METAL FLESH HOOPS ON FLOATING HEAD DRUMS

Heads may be tucked on metal flesh hoops and carried indefinitely without the hoop becoming warped. This is a great advantage when it becomes necessary to make a quick change. When tucking a head on a metal flesh hoop, let it become THOROUGHLY dry before putting on drum shell. Heads will never slip off metal flesh hoops if they are correctly tucked. Be sure to shove the head all the way under the flesh hoop, allowing a little to go BEYOND the outside corner as shown in Fig. 1. Never tuck like Fig. 2.



It is important to note that we have retained the kettle brackets as used on the hand-screw Tympani (see drawing at right) so that the strain of the head at each of the six points for the lowest note (with the pedal up as far as it will go) is applied to these brackets and NOT to the rods. This assures all rods pulling equally from the lowest to the highest note. The kettles are machine-drawn, one-piece finest quality "Superior" copper. The parts that are subjected to great strain are of the finest steel and are heavily nickel plated. The stand is aluminum and designed for maximum strength. The copper kettles are highly polished and contrast beautifully with the other metal parts. Leedy Tympani can be set up and ready to play in less than five minutes, and taken down for packing even more quickly. One simple connection and they are ready to tune. 
Note the Steel Ball Within the Tension Bracket. This ball is turned out of the same piece of steel as the threaded lug. When the pedal is up as far as it will go (the head at its lowest note) this ball seats itself in the bracket and transfers all the tension on the inside rods to the brackets. This enables the Tympanist to "iron out" the head at all six points without placing more tension on one rod than on another.

THE DOUBLE-FLANGED COUNTER HOOPS

The drawing to the right shows the extra strong double-flanged counter hoop. No need for more than six tension handles because of its tremendous strength. Fewer tension handles mean less effort to "set" the head and also add greatly to the appearance of the instrument. 

Music for mallet played instruments is customarily written two octaves lower than it actually sounds. Chime music, however. is usually written only one octave lower than it actually sounds. For example—the high C of orchestra bells (note C-88 on the chart) is identical in pitch to the highest C note on the piano but its musical notation is actually two octaves lower (C-64). The highest chime note (F-69) is written one octave lower than it sounds and receives the same notation on the staff as F-57 in the piano score.

NOTEWORTHY FEATURES OF SOLO-TONE MARIMBAS AND XYLOPHONES


Resonator Adjusting Device—Extreme temperatures affect the musical pitch of wood and metal in exactly the opposite directions. Excessive heat causes the tone of all wood bars to become somewhat flat and the metal resonators to become somewhat sharp. Excessive cold acts just the reverse. Therefore, in order to obtain the maximum volume of tone from each bar. under all temperature conditions, it is necessary to regulate the distance between the under side of the bars and the mouth of the resonators. In other words, we must place the air chamber in the resonators in exact "sympathy" with the bars so that both will vibrate in perfect unison. The Leedy Resonator Adjusting Device accomplishes this result. There are three sets of "step slots" in the frame at the bass end of all models except the Feather-Wate Xylophone. Place resonators in the center slot when temperature is from 75 to 85 degrees; place in upper slot when temperature is above 85 degrees, and place in lower slot when temperature is below 75 degrees.

Split Frames and Resonators—This feature prevents these parts from sagging. Built on the cantilever principle. The frames and resonators "break" in the middle by simply lifting apart. No thumb screws or bolts are used.

New Wheel Brakes —The two wheels nearest the performer on all Solo-Tone models now include a braking device. This prevents creeping or rolling away on uneven floors. Simple to operate by a slight pressure of the toe on the lever.

Sturdy, Rigid Stands—All Leedy Xylophone, Marimba and Vibraphone stands are as rigid as a library table. The stands come apart in a few pieces and the long center brace telescopes. Legs are of extra heavy angle steel. Note the smart, graceful lines. All stands are chromium plated unless ordered in Nobby Gold.






